PARENT & PAL NOTES

- Parent & Pal is a 24-hour program beginning Saturday morning (8:00-9:00am registration) to Sunday morning (ending about 9:30am after breakfast). It is the perfect introductory camping program for "new" or experienced campers. All you have to do is show up and set up your simple camping area. All meals and program are provided for you. Camp tents are available for you to use – or you can bring your own – whatever you are most comfortable with.
- Parent & Pal is a “complete package.” In order to reap all the benefits that our program provides, ***it is strongly recommended that you do not leave until after the closing ceremony on Sunday morning.*** Activities are presented in a round-robin format, so that everyone gets to experience everything that is offered. Participants walk from one activity to the next during the course of the day.
- ****Cub Scouts can attend Parent & Pal as a pack, den or individual family, but it should be one-on-one with your own Scout for the best camping experience. Moms or dads **or both** can attend. (Legal guardians and other family relatives – grandparents, etc. – are also welcome to attend.) (Note: If there are two or more Scouts in your family, it is okay to attend with one parent. And, again, both parents may attend with their Scout/s.)**
- **Note:** If you absolutely must bring another Scout with you whose parent cannot attend, you may do so. It is not recommended, but it is allowed. However, please be aware that you CANNOT sleep with a child other than your own. You will have to use two tents – one for yourself and your Scout and one for the other Scout.
- NEPA Council is committed to running a safe camping experience for everyone. If Scouts or parents have been sick, do not feel well, or have been in contact with anyone who is/has been sick within 5 days of the event we ask that they do not attend. By registering for this event, Scouts and parents agree and understand that COVID exposure cannot be eliminated, and risk is involved. Masks are optional for participants and staff. Hand sanitizing should still be done regularly.

- PARENT & PAL REFUND POLICY -

Camp will not be canceled because of rain. All program areas will either have cover or will take place indoors. Rain gear is necessary to walk from one program area to the next.

Fees are not refundable for cancellations made after 5:00pm on the Friday one week prior to the event or for no-shows the day of the event. A \$10 service charge will be deducted for each person cancelling.

In cases involving extreme circumstances (medical issue, death in the immediate family) or other reasons that do not involve choice, requests for a refund must be made in writing (standard mail or email) accompanied by appropriate documentation, by September 1 to the Service Center, for review by the Council Camping Committee. Any/all refunds may not be processed until after Sept. 1. This policy applies to adult fees also. **Any credit card processing fees are not refundable.**
